Policy: Dry Culvert Policy

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Revision:

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Coverage: This policy shall govern the installation of services underneath municipal roads in the Township of Huron-Kinloss.

Policy Statement: Road cuts made for the installation of dry culverts under municipal roads and the use of such culverts shall be regulated by the Township.

Legislative Authority: N/A

Contents: Road cuts are prohibited for installation of private works on all surface treated and hard-topped municipal roads. "Pushing" of infrastructure through the road beds shall be the preferred method.

Where dry culverts are used as conduits for other works, the owner shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Township, that there will be no threat to the environment through inadvertent discharges (manure piping systems).

Permit and deposit fees for installation shall be as established in the Township's Consolidated Fee By-Law, as amended.

Where in the opinion of the Township Director of Public Works, the works contemplated may undermine the construction of the road the Superintendent may refuse permission to the applicant.
