7.5 Ministry's Grants Transformation Process

In 2017/18 the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services began transforming its traditional grant programs to develop outcomes-based grant program that better supports local community safety and well-being. On September 7, 2017 we were advised that the 2018/19 fiscal year will be the last year which the Ministry offers the PAVIS, TAVIS, CPP and 1,000 Officer Grants. To ease the transition as the Ministry finalize an outcomes-based grant program eligible police services/boards will have the opportunity to either apply for funding under the PEM Grant or continue under the traditional policing grants in 2019/20. It is anticipated that the 2019/20 PEM Grants call-for-applications will be issued in fall 2018.
