Staff Comments: The Clerk has received one written appeal prior to the meeting. All appeals were to be received in writing 10 days prior to the date of the Court of Revision as per the Notice. The [Schedule of Assessments](#) has been attached for the Court of Revision's review.

The Drainage Superintendent has provided the following comments on the appeal submitted. "Although a topographical map would indicate that surface water from these properties would enter the Royal Oak Creek within the municipal drain area, it does not. Because the road ditch flows west along the 12th concession, this water does not enter the Royal Oak Creek until it becomes a natural watercourse. There is no culvert under the 12th to convey the water to the north down sideroad 20 to enter the municipal drain were it might be expected to run."
